

## Intec galvanises HazWaste funding

INTEC was awarded \$780,000 from the Victorian EPA's HazWaste Fund to progress its proposed \$2.85 million project with GB Galvanizing Service (GBG), applying its novel process for treating at least 1ML of spent pickle liquor from the galvanising industry annually.

Existing landfill-oriented stabilisation technologies produce some 2.3 tonnes of waste per tonne of wastewater treated. But Intec's heavy metals recycling process will yield zero waste, converting all materials to useful products.

Intec was introduced to GBG at last year's HazWaste Expo. Dave Sammut said winning funds to help develop the resulting project

"serves the exact goal" of the regulator, cutting waste and supporting clean technology. The EPA's 2009 expo is on November 10 in Melbourne.
